In 1934, Agustín Aragón (1903-1962) played a key role during Dirk Struik's first visit to Mexico City. Through his journalist column, Aragón publicly commented on the contents of Struik's lectures and personality. As a consequence, Struik and Aragón developed a genuine friendship that perdured until the early death of the last one. The goal of this talk is to discuss some of their extremelly contrasting mathematical, philosophical and ideological points of view. (Received September 29, 2000)
