Euler's Königsberg letters. Preliminary report.

We discuss three little-known letters, all sent in 1736, relating to the Königsberg bridges problem. These letters indicate clearly Euler's attitude to it, as a problem in the geometry of position, and to his solution of it. (Received October 02, 2000)
