In this talk I will describe a family of symplectic 4-manifolds with positive signature for any given fundamental group G that approaches the BMY line. The family is used to show that one cannot hope to do better than the BMY inequality in finding a lower bound for the function $f = \chi + b\sigma$ on the class of all minimal symplectic 4-manifolds with a given fundamental group.
