Over twenty percent of the graduate students in Mathematics at the University of Iowa are US minorites from groups underrepresented in Mathematics. Last year three US minority students earned Ph.D.'s in Mathematics at Iowa, approximately ten percent of the total nationally. Last May the Department received the Presidential Award for Excellence in Science, Mathematics and Engineering Mentoring for its work toward increasing the number of US minority Ph.D.'s in Mathematics.
