In this talk I will discuss how I use Camtasia studio tutorials in my courses at the University of Missouri. These tutorials are short (10-12) minute Camtasia Studio presentations which are packaged as SCORM content and placed on Blackboard. They include Flash quizzes which communicate with the Blackboard gradebook. I use these tutorials as an important part of my face to face courses, and I will discuss how they are used and provide a demonstration. In a purely online course, these tutorials can be sequenced together as SCORM and used as the primary means of content delivery. (Received September 27, 2006)
