In the early 40's Kulikov proved a well-known structure theorem on p-groups. As a consequence, every bounded p-group is a direct sum of cyclic groups; so the \mathbb{Z}_{p^n} -modules are just direct sums of ideals of \mathbb{Z}_{p^n} . Therefore, any preradical over this ring is determined by its behavior on these ideals, which form a finite chain of length n. The order lattice of preradicals over \mathbb{Z}_{p^n} is isomorphic to the order lattice of certain ascending paths over the plane $n \times n$ -lattice. We present some of its properties: finite with cardinality 2^n , distributive, self-dual and graded with rank $\frac{n(n+1)}{2}$. We also describe the correspondent posets of (co)irreducible and (co)prime elements. (Received January 15, 2004)
