We consider the behavior of the heat kernel, which is the fundamental solution to the heat equation, on a Riemannian polytopal complex, which is a polytopal complex with a Riemannian metric on each polytope. We are interested in the case where the Riemannian polytopal complex is a co-compact cover of a finitely generated group. Under some geometric assumptions on the complex, the large time on-diagonal behavior of the heat kernel on the complex is asymptotically equivalent up to constants to the return probability for the symmetric random walk on the group.
