In the recent proofs of functoriality for the split classical groups and some quasi-split examples, (partial) Bessel functions of local representations play a crucial role. In this talk (time permitting) I would like to explain the role these Bessel functions play in the proof of functoriality via the converse theorem and then explain a new result on the asymptotics of (partial) Bessel functions for quasi-split p-adic groups which should play a role in extending functoriality to new cases.
