We introduce a notion of small unitary representation for a semisimple Lie group. This is a natural generalization of the notion of minimal representation. Previous methods to study small representations, including the work of Howe, Sahi, Weissman and a recent work of Savin, are generally based on abelian harmonic analysis. Using Kostant's cascade of strongly orthogonal roots, we show how a new definition can be given in terms of Kirillov's method of orbits. As a result, we obtain refined estimates on the decay of matrix coefficients, which improve recent results by Li, Zhu and Oh. (Received November 29, 2004)
