A group G is said to have the property R_{∞} if every automorphism $\varphi \in \operatorname{Aut}(G)$ has an infinite number of φ -twisted conjugacy classes. Recent work of Gonçalves and Kochloukova uses the Bieri-Neumann-Strebel invariants $\Sigma^1(G)$ to show the property R_{∞} for a certain class of groups, including the generalized Thompson's groups $F_{0,n}$. In this talk, we make use of the invariants $\Omega^1(G)$ which are analogous to $\Sigma^1(G)$ to show the property R_{∞} for certain finitely generated groups. (Received September 09, 2009)
