In this talk we consider the second-order linear delay dynamic equation

$$(p(t)y^{\Delta}(t))^{\Delta} + q(t)y(\tau(t)) = 0$$

on a time scale T. By employing the Riccati transformation technique, we establish some sufficient conditions which ensure that every solution oscillates. The obtained results unify the oscillation of second-order delay differential and difference equations. We illustrate our results with examples. (Received September 22, 2009)
