Missouri Western State University and Davidson College have an active collaborative undergraduate research program in the area of synthetic biology. For four years, a combined team of undergraduate biology and mathematics majors from the two institutions, under the direction of a faculty mentoring team of one mathematician and one biologist from each institution, have worked together on synthetic biology projects related to bacterial computing.
