Learning new definitions is a vital skill for mathematics students. This paper seeks to describe several ways that junior mathematics students approached a new definition in a real analysis context. Students explored the definition by sketching graphs, re-wording the statement, looking for examples, negating the statement, finding non-examples and relating it to definitions students had already encountered.
