Change ringing is an art form that evolved in England several hundred years ago and is still practiced today. It involves bells of varying pitch being rung in sequences of permutations subject to certain constraints. In this talk we'll describe our investigation of the occurrence of various permutation groups in the construction of such sequences using the computational algebra package Magma.
