Math in the City is an interdisciplinary course in which students engage in a hands-on learning experience using mathematical modeling to understand current major societal issues of local and national interest. The course is run in collaboration with local businesses and research centers with students creating and analyzing models based on real data. In this talk I will focus on the structure and development of the course, the educational benefits, and also discuss some of the challenges that we have encountered.
