Let I be the defining ideal of a non-degenerate smooth integral curve of degree d and of genus g in \mathbb{P}^n where $n \geq 3$. We show that the degree lexicographic generic initial ideal of I has Castelnuovo-Mumford regularity $1 + \binom{d-1}{2} - g$ with the exception of two cases: (1) a rational normal curve in \mathbb{P}^3 and (2) an elliptic curve of degree 4 in \mathbb{P}^3 , where regularities are 3 and 4 respectively. Additionally we show that the regularity of degree lexicographic generic initial ideal of a non-degenerate integral scheme $X \subset \text{in } \mathbb{P}^n$ does not change by an isomorphic projection of X from a general point.
