Given a simple graph G, the corresponding edge ideal I_G is the ideal generated by the edges of G. The physical structure of the planar graph G provides insight into the algebraic properties of the minimal free resolution of S/I_G , where S is the polynomial ring over a field with variable set equal to the vertex set of G. In this talk, we will discuss the relationships between the planar graph G and the quotient ring S/I_G and how these relationships can be used to provide information regarding the algebraic structure of S/I_G .
