Totally geodesic submanifolds in locally symmetric spaces of non-compact type.

Given a connected, totally geodesic submanifold Y inside a compact locally symmetric space of non-compact type X, we provide a condition that ensures that Y is homologically non-trivial in X. In low dimensions (relative to the dimension of X), our sufficient condition is also necessary. We provide conditions under which there exist a tangential map of pairs from a finite cover of the pair (X,Y) to the non-negatively curved dual pair of spaces. (Received February 12, 2008)
