There is a myth that students need to have a lot of math to do research. This is false. For the last five summers there has been a Pre-REU for students who have at least two semesters of calculus. This is one part of Texas A&M's Mentoring through Critical Transistion Points program as part of an NSF grant. In this part students learn about signal and image processing and work in groups, first to work through a loosely guided project, and then to expand it to their own work. This talk will contain a discussion of the results, both mathematical and educational, including the effect on the students as they progressed through their education and went to graduate school or work.
