There are programs that are specifically for women and/or minorities, but what about mentoring underrepresented groups in programs not specifically for them? For five years there have been four programs at Texas A&M University, sponsored on an NSF Mentoring through Critical Transitions Grant, that have been successful in encouraging women and minorities to continue in STEM fields, mostly in mathematics.
