We prove a differential analog of a theorem of Chevalley on extending homomorphisms for rings with commuting derivations, generalizing a theorem of Kac. As a corollary, we establish that, under suitable hypotheses, the image of a differential scheme under a finite morphism is a constructible set. We also obtain a new algebraic characterization of differentially closed fields. We show that related results hold for differentially closed fields that are saturated, in the sense of model theory.
