Bordered Floer homology is an extension of the Heegaard Floer invariant HF-hat to 3-manifolds with parametrized boundary. It enjoys good properties with respect to gluing, and can be computed in many cases. In this talk we will discuss how similar structures occurring in related fields (including Khovanov homology, contact homology and Floer theory) led to bordered Floer homology.
