Codes in Random Network Coding. Preliminary report.

Yeung & Zhang introduced the concept of network coding theory in 1999. Since then, network coding theory has become very popular because of its wide applications. Koetter & Kschischang in 2008 considered a random network coding and introduced the Hamming bound, the G-V bound, and the Singleton bound for codes in the finite-field Grassmannian.
