A user's guide – at the same time humanistic and technical – is written to accompany a published or soon-to-be-published research article, providing further exposition and context for the results. Enchiridion is a new informal annual journal that brings together five mathematicians from a common subfield to write user's guides on their own papers, then work closely together to collaboratively group-edit and peer-review a compilation. The goal of this online-only journal is to make research mathematics more accessible, to explore unconventional expositional styles, and to augment rigor with humanistic meta-data.
