Enhanced Guides to the Mathematical Literature.

The mathematical literature has never been more widely available. Digital publishing has enabled great innovations, coming from large, established publishers and from small, new publishers. Navigating the world of online literature is not easy. Various guides to the literature exist, both old and new. Advances in technology allow these guides to be more than just roadmaps. They can also provide information obtained from statistics, from meta-data, or from human input.
