I will share my experiences in the creation and teaching of two courses at my home institution that cover the material on the actuarial exams Probability P/1 and Financial Mathematics FM/2. By continually putting the students in an exam-like setting, these courses serve a dual purpose of teaching the material and building problem-solving skills. The results have been overwhelmingly positive. I will focus of the strengths and the drawbacks of this style of teaching, and I will share some of the personal successes of some of our students.
