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The dynamics in the illocutions of Searle type can be measured as the relations between the illocutionary commitments as they worked out. This system of measurement is similar to that of psychological states in a sense that we cannot judge the forces in the utterance as it appeared. Hence it cannot be done within the linguistic observations only. But it should be measured in terms of the effect of illocutionary acts enough to say that it is more than linguistic work as the study of order in Aristotle. First, the criteria to judge the effects of the illocutionary act cannot be limited in the linguistic works only but they should consider all in our life world. Second, as the historical facts, the effects of the illocutionary act can be measured. Language has been accepted to try to use the finite means for the infinite goals. Therefore the illocutionary effects appeared already only should be the observed data as the eligible in this dynamics in the illocutions measurement, I think. (Received November 25, 2012)
