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It is known that starting from a tight Gabor frame for  $L^2(\mathbb{R})$  with redundancy 2, one can construct an orthonormal Wilson basis for  $L^2(\mathbb{R})$  whose generator is well-localized in the time-frequency plane. But it remains unknown whether such construction can be done if the initial tight Gabor frame has a redundancy different from 2. In this talk, we show that one can construct multi-dimensional orthonormal Wilson bases starting from tight Gabor frames of redundancy  $2^k$  where  $k = 1, 2, \dots, d$ . These results generalize most of the known results about the existence of orthonormal Wilson bases. The talk is based on a joint work with M. Bownik, M. Jokobsen, and J. Lemvig.
