A cowreath in a monoidal category is a generalization of entwining structures. A Morita context for preGalois and coFrobenius cowreath is constructed. Using this context, we characterize Galois cowreath and when the maps of the context are bijective. Moreover, the separability of the extension associated to the cowreath is studied.
