THE FEBRUARY MEETING IN NEW YORK

The five hundred forty-third meeting of the American Mathematical Society was held at Hunter College in New York City on Saturday, February 22, 1958. The meeting was attended by about 150 persons including 140 members of the Society.

By invitation of the Committee to Select Hour Speakers for Eastern Sectional Meetings Professor Louis Nirenberg of New York University delivered an address entitled On partial differential equations of elliptic type at a general session presided over by Professor R. E. Langer. Sessions for contributed papers were held in the morning and afternoon, presided over by Professor Mary Dolciani and Dr. E. J. Taft.
