

THE JUNE MEETING IN MISSOULA

The five hundred seventieth meeting of the American Mathematical Society was held at Montana State University in Missoula, Montana on Saturday, June 18, 1960. There was a meeting of the Mathematical Association of America and the Society for Industrial and Applied Mathematics on Friday, June 17. These meetings were attended by approximately 50 people; 31 members of the Society registered.

By invitation of the Committee to Select Hour Speakers for Far Western Sectional Meetings, Professor Samuel Karlin of Stanford University addressed the Society on *Total positivity and applications to probability*. He was introduced by Professor T. G. Ostrom.
