THE OCTOBER MEETING IN NEW YORK

The Council met in the Grand Lounge of the Sheraton-Russell Hotel in New York on Friday, October 25, 1974, at 4:00 P.M.

The Council received an interim report from the Committee on the Emergency Employment Situation in Mathematics. The Council took the following position:

The Council of the AMS adopts the principles that all positions in the mathematical sciences shall insofar as practicable be advertised, and that the standard place for advertisements to appear is the publication Employment Information for Mathematicians.

The Council then passed the following motion:

The Council recommends a feasibility study and eventual publication on a regular basis (annual, biannual, etc.) of a list of nonacademic employers of members of AMS, MAA, and SIAM, by states and cities, combined with a separate list showing brief job descriptions of persons employed by employers in the first list.

The Council accepted the resignation of Shlomo Sternberg from the position of Member of the Editorial Committee of the Transactions and Memoirs. They then elected Alexandra Ionescu Tulcea to the position. [The Board of Trustees subsequently approved the election.]

The Council authorized the appointment of a number of committees. One is a Committee on Mathematical Models as Used in Governmental Policy Decisions.

The President Elect announced his intent of appointing a Committee on Committees, to examine the selection, activity, and function of Society committees.
