The American Mathematical Society is delighted that the Senate has passed bipartisan legislation that will bolster US competitiveness through new investments in science and technology. We are especially encouraged to see included several provisions from the House-led COMPETES bill that will expand our national capacity to advance research and broaden participation in STEM fields.

This will in large part be done by enhancing the role of the National Science Foundation (Title III of HR 4346). Further, we are pleased to see provisions to enhance rural STEM, boost achievement at Minority Serving Institutions (MSIs) and combat sexual harassment in science (Title V), and also to support early-career researchers (Title VI).
