- Eight research teams will be formed, each team consisting of a senior mentor, two younger mathematicians (advanced graduate students or young professionals) based in Latin America and two younger mathematicians (advanced graduate students or young professionals) based in the U.S.
- Teams will be convened by the various Special Sessions at the Joint Meeting in December around a research problem of common interest articulated as part of the Special Session.
- Team mentors will frame the continuing contact and collaboration of their research teams throughout 2011.

Travel Awards will be made if funding is approved by the National Science Foundation. Travel and living expenses during the Joint Meeting will be covered for selected applicants. Funding will be limited to US citizens or individuals connected to US institutions. Travel must be booked on US-Flag Air carriers if available. Application deadline is 11:59 p.m. Eastern Time October 1, 2010.
