Proving a conjecture of Pop, we show that if L and K are finitely generated fields with $(L, +, \times, 0, 1) \equiv (K, +, \times, 0, 1)$, then $L \cong K$. This theorem follows from our stronger result that if K is an infinite finitely generated field, then K is parametrically biinterpretable with $(\mathbb{N}, +, \times, 0, 1)$.
