Lower bounds on the rate of decrease in time of a uniform radius of spatial analyticity for the solutions of the derivative Schrödinger equation

$$iu_t + u_{xx} = i(|u|^2u)_x$$

will be presented. The bounds depend algebraically on time and are global as long as the L^2 -norm of the initial datum is of order 1 (which is consistent with the derivation of the model) and the initial datum satisfies suitable spatial decay requirements on the real axis.
