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Lyubeznik conjectured that for an ideal \mathfrak{a} of a regular ring R , the local cohomology modules $H_{\mathfrak{a}}^i(R)$ have finitely many associated primes. This implies, in particular, that for a polynomial ring R over the ring of integers, a module of the form $H_{\mathfrak{a}}^i(R)$ has p -torsion for at most finitely many prime integers p .
