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Interval digraphs have attracted some interest, but they lack the appeal of undirected interval graphs. We introduce a restricted version of interval digraphs and conjecture that they are precisely the digraphs for which the list homomorphism problems are tractable. We suggest that this class may be more appealing than the usual interval digraphs, and conjecture an analogue of the Lekkerkerker - Boland theorem for these ‘adjusted’ interval digraphs.
