We prove pointwise a posteriori error estimates for semi- and fully-discrete finite element methods for approximating the solution u to a parabolic model problem. Our estimates may be used to bound $\|u - u_h\|_{L^\infty(D)}$, where D is an arbitrary subset of the space-time domain of definition of the given PDE. When implemented in an adaptive method, these estimates should allow for efficient and accurate computation of u on D by requiring only enough mesh refinement away from D in order to ensure that local solution quality is not polluted by global effects.
