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A twisted knot K_n is a knot obtained from the unknot by performing a $(-\frac{1}{n})$ -Dehn surgery along a trivial knot C , for instance, Figure 1 shows that K_{+1} is the twist knot. In this talk, we will classify twisting of knots with crossing number less or equal to ten, and give, for the first time, the smallest non-twisted knot in this family. (Received September 13, 2009)
