*Rack modules and (t,s)-racks.*

Rack modules are representations of a certain algebra defined from a finite rack. These structures are related to a type of rack known as a (t,s)-rack. In this talk we will see new knot and link invariants defined via enhancement of the rack counting invariant using these rack module and (t,s)-rack structures. (Received August 16, 2010)
