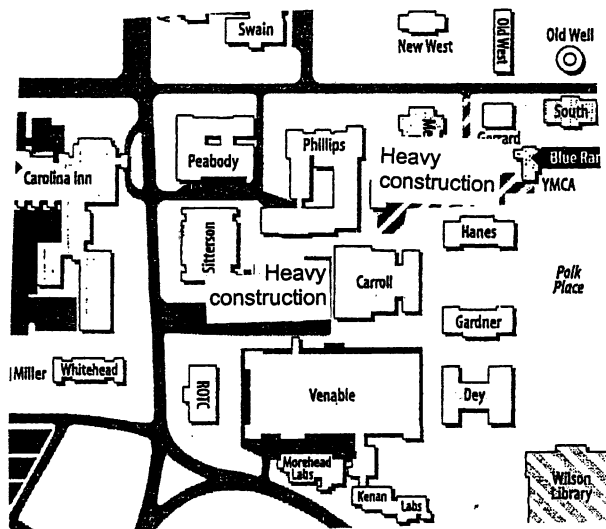


American Mathematical Society Regional Meeting - Chapel Hill 24-25 October 2003

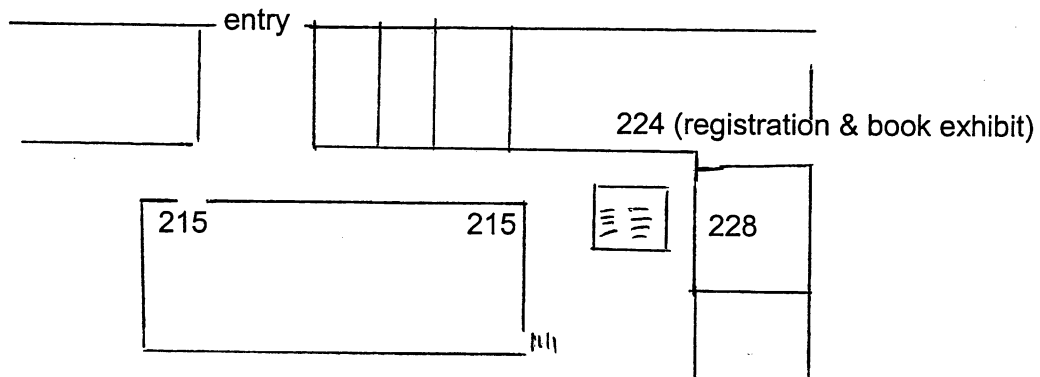
The map below shows all the buildings on the UNC campus that will be used for the Meeting, as well as some others that may be helpful as landmarks. Up is north on the map. Phillips Hall, the registration site, is above the center. The heavy construction sites to the right of and below Phillips all but force Conference attendees to stay on the only path that joins all the conference sites. Carroll Hall is below Phillips, and should be entered from the east (front) side in order to find the plenary lecture auditorium, no. 111. Hanes, Gardner and Dey Halls are in a column to the right of Carroll. To sound like a Tar Heel, pronounce Dey like "die."
