

Call for Proposals for the 2017 AMS Short Courses

The AMS Short Course Subcommittee invites submissions of preliminary proposals for Short Courses on fields of application of mathematics, to be given at the 2017 Joint Mathematics Meetings. Members are also invited to submit names of colleagues who they think would conduct an inspiring short course. A short course consists of a coherent sequence of survey lectures and discussions on a single theme. A Short Course ordinarily extends over a period of two days immediately preceding the Joint Mathematics Meetings held in January. Usually there are about six different lecturers, and it is anticipated that the proceedings of the Short Course will be published in the series *Proceedings of Symposia in Applied Mathematics*.

Preliminary proposals may be as short as one page. After reviewing the preliminary proposals, the Subcommittee may ask for more details from some of the proposers. Proposals should be sent via email to Associate Executive Director (aed-mps@ams.org) with a cc to Robin Hagan Aguiar (rha@ams.org). For full consideration for the 2017 Short Courses, proposals should be submitted by **December 21, 2015**.
