Don has served on numerous AMS, MAA, and SIAM committees and was chair of the organizing committee for the 1988 SIAM National Meeting. He has held many editorial positions, including the managing editorship of the *SIAM Journal on Mathematical Analysis*. More recently, Don resurrected the *Bulletin of the AMS* by encouraging the editorial board to work harder and by thinking imaginatively of the role that the *Bulletin* might play. For example, one early issue under Don's editorship boasted contributions by Birkhoff and Poincaré.

In summary, Don Saari has all of the talents and attributes of an ideal president of the AMS. He will forward the interests of mathematics, both in its core disciplines and its more applied directions. He will succeed in raising the visibility of mathematics and promoting its importance to the nation. He will champion excellence in research, teaching, and exposition.
