The cover photograph shows Armand Borel and Harish-Chandra in Princeton, presumably about the time they were writing their classic paper on the reduction theory of arithmetic groups. Borel's daughter, Dominique, commented, "As a child I remember being over at the house of Harish-Chandra, who lived right next door, during very warm weather (at the time my father and HC were working most intensely together) and the two of them pacing back and forth across the lawn over and over and over again in deep discussion.
