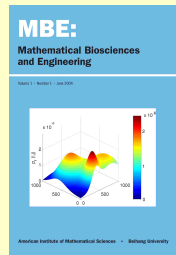
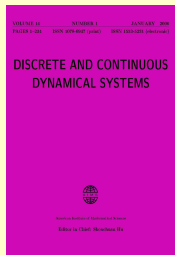

AIMS publishes twelve high quality journals ranging from electronic announcements to mathematical theory and methods to applied mathematics (modeling and computations).

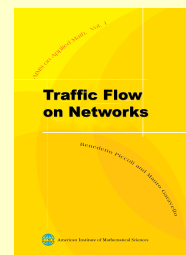
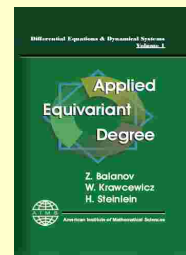

Proposals for new books are welcome.

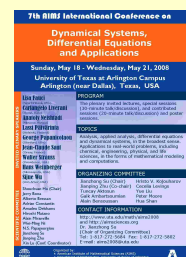


Conferences
