

# Call for NOMINATIONS

The selection committees for these prizes request nominations for consideration for the 2009 awards, which will be presented at the Joint Mathematics Meetings in Washington, DC, in January 2009. **RUTH LYTTLE SATTER PRIZE.** The Ruth Lyttle Satter Prize is presented every two years in recognition of an outstanding contribution to mathematics research by a woman in the previous six years.

**ALBERT LEON WHITEMAN MEMORIAL PRIZE.** The Albert Leon Whiteman Memorial Prize is awarded every four years, for notable exposition on the history of mathematics. The ideas expressed and understandings embodied in that exposition should reflect exceptional mathematical scholarship.

Nominations for all prizes should be submitted to the secretary, Robert J. Daverman, American Mathematical Society, 312D Ayres Hall, University of Tennessee, Knoxville, TN 37996-1330. Include a short description of the work that is the basis of the nomination, with complete bibliographic citations when appropriate. A brief curriculum vitae should be included for the nominee. The nominations will be forwarded by the secretary to the appropriate prize selection committee, which, as in the past, will make final decisions on the awarding of these prizes.

**Deadline for nominations is June 30, 2008.**
