We invite qualified students to apply for admission to our first doctoral class, entering September 2010. Applications received by Jan. 2, 2010 will receive full consideration. All applicants are considered for teaching assistantships, which provide a stipend, tuition remission, and full health insurance.

We have very strong and focused research groups in Geometry/Topology and Number Theory/Representation Theory. Graduate students will be part of a close-knit departmental community and will have ample opportunities to participate in the expansive Boston research community. Our program will be small, thereby facilitating close interaction between students and faculty.

We take pride in our teaching and will provide considerable support (including a teaching seminar) to our graduate students as they develop their teaching skills.
