2014 Mathematics Research Communities

The American Mathematical Society invites individuals and groups of individuals to serve as organizers of the conferences of the Mathematics Research Communities (MRC) program to be held in Snowbird, Utah, during the summer of 2014.

The goal of the MRC program is to create research cohorts of early career mathematicians that will sustain themselves over time, fostering joint research and coherent research programs. The MRC program aims to achieve this goal through:

- One-week conferences in each topic area in summer 2014
- AMS Special Sessions at the Joint Mathematics Meetings in January 2015
- Discussion networks
- Longitudinal study
