If your institution does not grant tenure, report those with renewable full-time appointments. *Faculty on leave should be included.*
- New Hires means any tenured/tenure-track assistant professor whose appointment begins Fall 2016.
- *Salary means* payment by the institution for full-time work for the academic year, *9–10 months*, even if paid over 11–12 months.

Note:

The one female Assistant Professor whose full-time academic-year salary is reported between \$55,000 and \$59,999 is the one on a 11–12 month appointment. Her salary for the appointment is \$70,000, but this figure is multiplied by 0.8 to reach the equivalent academic-year salary of \$56,000 reported on this form.

The one Full Professor whose full-time academic-year salary is reported between \$65,000 and \$69,999 is half-time (0.5 FTE) in the department but full-time at the university.
